CHARACTERS

SNOWY, A SNOWMAN GINGER, A GINGERBREAD MAN SANTA CLAUS RUDOLPH, THE REINDEER

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SCENE 1. 24th December

(A city in the North, with the roofs made of slate. There is a snowman in the middle of the square. We can hear the sounds of kids singing Jingle Bells. A gingerbread man is leaning against the snowman. The bells are pealing.)

Ginger: Snowy?

Snowy: What is it, Ginger?
Ginger: Did you hear that?
Snowy: I didn't hear anything.

Ginger: What do you mean you didn't?

Snowy: I can't hear very well. If you could just take away this sock the kids put in my ear...

(Ginger comes to life and takes away the sock.)

Snowy: I can hear now. What is it?

Ginger: I don't know, but we should find out!

Snowy: Look, Ginger!
Ginger: What is it?
Snowy: The kids!

Ginger: Kids? Where? **Snowy:** Over there!

Ginger: Aha! So YOU did it! What do you mean, you didn't? Repeat after me. Dong... Alright,

it wasn't you. It sounds different. Snowy, show them what we heard.

(The bell rings.)

Ginger: Alright Snowy, you're doing it very well.

Snowy: It wasn't me.

(The bell sounds again.)

Ginger: Here it goes again.
Snowy: Yup, it's the bell.

Ginger: Hey, bell! Why are you ringing?





(The bell rings again.)

Ginger: Oh, it says we have to look at the calendar.

Snowy: Which calendar?

Ginger: I think he means this one (*Pointing at the calendar*) ESook, Snowy, today is 24th of December.

Snowy: So, what does it mean?

Ginger: Let me think.

Snowy: Yes, I'm going to think, too.

(Both walk along next to each other, thinking.)

Ginger: I know!

Snowy: What is it? What is it?

Ginger: 24th of December is... my birthday! Yeah! Let's celebrate!

Snowy: Ginger...

Ginger: Yes?

Snowy: Today is not your birthday...

Ginger: How do you know?

Snowy: Because your birthday was yesterday...

Ginger: You are right, Snowy! Well... then it's yours! **Snowy:** Nope... mine was the day before yesterday!

Ginger: Then I have no idea why 24th December is so important....

Snowy: Look, Ginger!
Ginger: What is it?

Snowy: There are kids playing with a sleigh.

Ginger: Snowy, please, concentrate! We need to remember what day it is today... What did you say?

Snowy: The kids.

Ginger: What are they doing?

Snowy: Playing.

Ginger: But with what? With what?!

Snowy: With a sleigh!

Ginger: Oh of course! 24th December... Tomorrow is Christmas Day!

Snowy: Christmas! I can sing my favourite carol. "Jingle bells, jingle bells, jingle all the way..."

Ginger: (Interrupting.) Yes, you can, Snowy. It is my favourite carol, too. But it is a very important

carol; we have to sing it on Christmas day, by the tree, after singing other carols, opening the

presents and eating pudding, watching the snow fall.

Snowy: But Ginger... we don't have any of that.





Ginger: Huh? (Looking behind him, up and down.) You are right. There is no tree, no pudding, no

presents...

Snowy: No snow, no carols, nothing!

Ginger: Arghhh!

(They start running around in despair.)

Ginger: Disaster!

Snowy: How could we forget?

Ginger: And now what are going to do?

Snowy: What if we are too late!

Ginger: We have only 1 day left! (*Pause.*) We should calm down.

Snowy: ...and now what! Terrible!

Ginger: Calm down...

Snowy: We won't be able to celebrate Christmas!

Ginger: Ca-alm do-own...

Snowy: Oh...

Ginger: I have an idea. Bring the board, Snowy!

Snowy: I'm on my way!

Ginger: We shall make a to-do list. (To the audience.) By the way, we didn't introduce ourselves. I am

Ginger.

Snowy: And I am Snowy.

Ginger: Alright, the first thing would be...

(Snowy starts acting something out with gestures for Ginger to guess.)

Snowy: Compose a carol. Of course! Put it down.

(Snowy picks up an image of a notes staff from the box which says Christmas and puts it on a blackboard.)

Ginger: Good, what else?

(Snowy continues with the game.)

Ginger: Dolls, planes and bows for the presents. Alright! Write it down!

(Snowy takes a picture of a present from the same box and puts it on a blackboard.)





Ginger: Then... let me think...

(Snowy starts playing again.)

Ginger: A giant! No. A Christmas tree!

(Snowy puts an image on the blackboard.)

Ginger: Well done...

(Snowy keeps miming.)

Ginger: You're laughing at me! I have something in my hair... On my nose... How embarrassing! No?

Oh, I know. Positive attitude! Very important! Knowing how to laugh!

(Snowy puts a smile on the blackboard.)

Ginger: What else?

(Snowy touches his own belly.)

Ginger: Yes, I'm hungry too. Let's eat something. No? Oh Christmas food! The pudding! Of course!

(Snowy puts it on the blackboard.)

Ginger: Very good. That's all! **Snowy:** Just one thing left...

Ginger: What?

Snowy: The snow. If it doesn't snow, I will melt!

Ginger: Of course! It must snow.

(Snowy puts it on the blackboard.)

Ginger: Now, that's all.

Snowy: And one more thing!

Ginger: What?

Snowy: Jingle bells!





(Snowy puts it on the board.)

Ginger: YES!

Snowy: (Singing.) Jingle bells, jingle bells, jingle...

Ginger: Snowy, this is the last one! See, it's the last one on our list. First, we have to do other things.

Snowy: You're right, Ginger.

Ginger: Let's find a piano then. We need to compose a carol. You know what Snowy, songs are even

more fun when we make them together.

(Snowy starts playing the piano.)

Ginger: No Snowy, play faster!

(Snowy plays faster.)

Ginger: Nooo, not that fast! Somewhere in the middle. (*Humming.*) Tum tum tum...

(Snowy plays more slowly.)

Ginger: (Sings off key.) "Deck the halls with boughs of holly, fa la la la la..."

Snowy: That wasn't very good...

Ginger: ...Fa la la la la..."

Snowy: Now that's better.

Ginger: This the season to be jolly, "Fa la la la la, la la la la"

Snowy: Wow, that sounds wonderful! But it would sound even better if the kids could help us...

Ginger: Well, then maybe the kids over here could sing "FA LA LA LA LA", and the ones over there

could sing "LA LA LA LA"? Alright, let's try it!

(They sing.)

Snowy: Yup, sounds great!

(Everybody sings Deck The Halls.)

Snowy: But I don't know how to.... Why don't you do it?

Ginger: No, you... you do it. I am busy.

Snowy: Busy?

Ginger: Fine. I don't know how to do it.

Snowy: Hahaha! he doesn't know! He doesn't know!

Ginger: Neither do you!

Snowy: Oops. That's true...

Ginger: We need somebody who knows a lot about Christmas.

Snowy: Yes! A Christmas expert!

Ginger: And who knows more about Christmas than...

Ginger and Snowy: Santa Claus!

Ginger: Alright, let's call Santa Claus. Santa! Santa! Hmm, nobody's there.

Snowy: What if we sing him a song?

Ginger: Don't be silly. Better call him with a song!

Snowy: But that's what I said.

Ginger: The chorus goes like this, kids: "Santa Claus is coming to town". You repeat after me: "Santa

Claus is coming to town"!

(Everybody sings Santa Claus Is Coming To Town.)

(During the song Santa comes with a bag full of presents. Acts out the words to the song. He makes a list of presents. He looks into the windows of the houses. If the child has been good, he gives him a present.)

Santa: Did someone call me?

Ginger: Hello, Santa. It was us!

Santa: Alright kids, what do you want? Don't you know what day it is today?

Snowy: What day is it today?

Ginger: I don't know. Today is...

Santa: 24th December!
Snowy: Oh, of course!

Santa: Today is the most important day of the year. All the kids are waiting for their presents tonight.

I am in a big hurry! (Starts to leave.)

(Snowy and Ginger look sad.)





Santa: (Feeling sorry for them.) Hey, hey! What's the matter?

Snowy: Can I tell him? Can I, Can I?

Ginger: Fine. Tell him.

Snowy: I... I don't remember. You tell him, Ginger.

Ginger: Santa, tomorrow is Christmas and we haven't done anything about it. We don't know what to

do. We called you, since you are the one who knows all about Christmas. Can you help us?

Snowy: (Doing puppy eyes.) Could you help us, please?

Santa: Don't worry. I will help you, but we must hurry. I have a lot of work to do.

Ginger and Snowy: HOORAY! **Ginger:** We made a list...

Santa: Let's see what we have here. Presents, of course, we have to deliver the presents tonight.

Well, we will need some kids to help us!

(Ginger and Snowy invite some kids onto the stage.)

Santa: Alright, the BOX. Here, you take the box. THE BOW. You will put on the bow. The STAMP. You

will put on the stamp and the address. THE LIST. You will check it on the list. The BAG. You

will put it in the bag. But you have to do all this to the music.

(The kids do all this together with Santa, Snowy and Ginger. They do it to Santa's rhythm which varies from as fast as they can because they are in a hurry, to a very slow one because they get tired.)

Ginger: Looks like we have all the presents ready!

Snowy: "Jingle bells, Jingle bells..."

Ginger: What are you doing, Snowy?

Snowy: We have finished. So I am singing "Jingle Bells".

Ginger: We haven't finished. We still have a lot of things to do (*Pointing at the blackboard.*) Also,

why do YOU have to sing the song? I have a better voice!

Snowy: Oh, not at all. My voice is better!

Ginger: No it's not!

Santa: Hey, hey, no need to fight! We will have a singing contest.

Ginger: That sounds fair...

Snowy: I will show you how to sing.

Santa: Well, as you know, celebrating Christmas is very important. It is not easy to do it well. So you

will welcome Christmas with a song. Each one of you will sing his part. (To the audience.) When they finish, you will applaud a lot if you like it. If you don't like it, you applaud less. The

one who wins will sing the final carol.





(Snowy and Ginger face each other. They start singing We Wish You a Merry Christmas, each in his own way. They stop after each turn to let the children applaud.)

SCENE 3. OF TREES AND STARS

Santa: Shall we continue?

(The bell sounds.)

Ginger: We don't have much time left. Let's see what we have already done.

Snowy: I wrote a Christmas carol.

(Ginger looks at him with surprise.)

Snowy: Fine, WE wrote a carol.

Ginger: We have also wrapped the presents.

Santa: Now it is time to decorate the tree.

Ginger: But how?

Snowy: It is very difficult.

Ginger: We need help. Maybe we can do it all together.

(Snowy and Ginger get the kids onto the stage.)

Santa: You have to help us make the Christmas tree. Here you have some pieces. We have to put

them on the tree, each in its special place...

(Snowy and Ginger bring the Christmas tree. It is made like a puzzle to be completed. The kids have to choose the right pieces to use. The kids from the audience can help them with instructions.)

Santa: Well done! We did it!

Ginger: Yup, we have the tree now.

Snowy: But it needs to be decorated.

Ginger: You're right. We need some stars! But can we get them from?

Snowy: From the North Pole!

Ginger: But that is so far, we will never reach it!

Santa: If we go in my sleigh, we will be there in a minute! But, I will stay there as I have to prepare

some things for tonight.

(They get in the sleigh and sing Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star as they pick the stars.)





TWINKLE, TWINKLE LITTLE STAR

Twinkle, twinkle, little star, How I wonder what you are! Up above the world so high, Like a diamond in the sky. Twinkle, twinkle, little star, How I wonder what you are!

Ginger: Now we have the stars!

Snowy: It's time to put them on the tree!

(They put the stars on the tree and it starts to glow.)

SCENE 4. POSITIVE ATTITUDE

(Ginger looks a bit sad.)

Snowy: Hey, Ginger, what's the matter?

Ginger: It's just... we have to do so much and there is so little time.

Snowy: Don't be sad. Look, it says in our list: positive attitude.

Ginger: And how do we do that?

Snowy: By laughing.

Ginger: Laughing? Like this: ha ha! (Laughing without enthusiasm.)

(Snowy starts crying.)

Ginger: What's wrong?

Snowy: Your laughter is so sad...

Ginger: You are right... Does anyone know how to laugh? Well, this laughter is very poor. We have to

learn because it is very important.

(Snowy smacks Ginger on the head.)





Ginger: What are you doing?

(Snowy laughs.)

Ginger: It's the other way around!

(Snowy smacks him again.)

Ginger: Alright, it's enough. It's not funny!

Snowy: Well, I do think it's funny, Ginger! Ha ha ha!

Ginger: No, no, no...

(Enter Rudolph.)

Rudolph: I heard somebody laughing. I like that!

Ginger: Hello Rudolph! I'm glad you're here! We are learning how to laugh. You do that a lot, don't

you?

Rudolph: Oh yes! I love laughing, it makes me feel good! I don't like crying, it makes me feel sad. Being

happy is the best.

Snowy: And how do you do that?

Rudolph: It's very easy! I just think about all the things that I like.

Snowy: Like what?

Rudolph: I like cake, playing with my friends, sledging, throwing snowballs... (Laughs.) See, I thought

about it, and it made me laugh!

Ginger: Can you teach us?

Rudolph: No problem! First, everybody think about something you like very, very much. Got it? Don't

say what it is. Now open your mouth very, very wide. Now take in the air like this. Good! And now everybody say HA! Very good! And again... Well, we got the first laughter! Now let's do it

to music!

(They sing the song with "Ha ha ha" in which each group has a part.)

Snowy: We already have our positive attitude. And now... "Jingle..." (Ginger puts his hand over

Snowy's mouth.) "...Jingle..." (Ginger stops him again.) "...Jin..." (Again.) What's the matter,

why won't you let me sing?

Ginger: Because we still have things to do! Look at the list!

(The bell sounds. They start running around chaotically.)





Snowy: We're getting close. I 'm hungry!

Ginger: Now?

Snowy: Well, it says here: make Christmas food.

SCENE 5. PUDDING AND SOMETHING ELSE

Ginger: All right! Let's make some food.

Rudolph: Can I help?

Ginger: Sure, Rudolph, we need your help. And the kids' help, too.

(Snowy and Rudolph get some kids onto the stage. They put aprons on them. They give every child an ingredient: salt, sugar, gelatine, a carrot, an apple and milk.)

Ginger: I need the ingredients. First, sugar. Put it right there (A big bowl, Ginger stirs it.) Now a little

bit of salt. Now the gelatine. Then, a carrot, an apple and some milk. Let's see. (He tastes it.) We need some more salt. Alright, done! (He takes out a giant pudding, and let's everybody

try it.) A big round of applause for the kids!

Ginger: It seems we are ready. You can sing now!

Snowy: Yay! "Jingle bells, jingle bells..."

Rudolph: Hey you guys, it says here that we need snow.

Ginger: Snow?

Snowy: Look, I'm melting! (His nose falls off.)

Rudolph: Keep calm, I know a trick. If you really want something to happen, it comes true. The most

important things come with dreams.

Snowy: Let's dream it!

Ginger: Ok, alright. Let's go to sleep and dream about snow...

Snowy: I'm already asleep.

Ginger: If you're talking, you aren't asleep.

Snowy: I am now!

Ginger: I don't believe you.

Snowy: Ginger?

Ginger: Yes, Snowy?

Snowy: I can't sleep. Can you sing me a lullaby?

Ginger: Fine, let's sing a lullaby...

(They sing "Silent Night". A puppet choir sings with them. The stars in the sky come out and the tree lights up. Everybody falls asleep.)
