SCENE 1. GOLDILOCKS' BIRTHDAY

(Enter Goldilocks.)

GOLDILOCKS:

(To the audience:)

Hello!!! Good Morning. I must be deaf because I can't hear a word you're saying. Hello! Wow! So many people. My name is Goldilocks, but don't tell anyone. I'm playing hide and seek with my parents. Do you know how to hide? Ok! Let's see: 3,2,1... Hide. Wow! That's incredible. Where are you guys? Oh! I know, you are still hiding.

Hey! Listen, my parents are here. Please, don't tell them where I am.

(She hides.)

FATHER: Goldilocks!

(Father enters.)

FATHER: One, two, three, four, and five.... I'm coming!

MOTHER: Oh Darling, look. There are so many people here. Maybe they can help us. Have you seen

Goldilocks?

(Wait for audience to reply.)

FATHER: Shhhhhhh! Today is Goldilocks' birthday, and we have prepared a special surprise for

her. A big teddy bear. And a delicious birthday cake!





(Mother brings out a birthday cake.)

(To audience:)

Can you help us sing happy birthday to Goldilocks?

(A bear enters but Mother sees him and starts shouting.)

FATHER: Oh! What is it?

MOTHER: A bear! A bear!

FATHER: Please, Mr bear. Be quiet!

(To the audience)

Oh! I hate bears! They are dirty!

BEAR: I am not dirty.

(The bear looks very angry.)

(Enter Goldilocks.)

GOLDILOCKS: Safe! Dad, I'm safe!

MOTHER: Be careful Goldilocks. The bear looks very angry.

FATHER: He also looks very hungry.

GOLDILOCKS: He looks very friendly. Hello Cutie.





(She hugs the bear.)

FATHER: Don't do that Goldilocks. Bears are evil.

GOLDILOCKS: Animals are not evil dad. Look: he is my friend.

(The bear and Goldilocks dance. The parents look calmer than before.)

GOLDILOCKS: Are you leaving now? Oh I will miss you.

BEAR: (He roars saying goodbye.)

FATHER: Oh! He scared us.

MOTHER: Goldi, do you remember what day it is today?

GOLDILOCKS: Yes... Is it Christmas day?

FATHER: No, today is... Your birthday my darling daughter.

MOTHER: Oh yes.

FATHER: (To the audience.)

And they're going to help us sing happy birthday to you.

(Her parents and the audience sing Happy Birthday to Goldilocks and give her a present and a birthday cake.)

MOTHER: Come on Goldilocks, open it!

GOLDILOCKS: (Opening her present.) Oh! It's a Teddy Bear. I think he is going to be my friend.

FATHER: Ok, can I have a piece of cake?





GOLDILOCKS: No, this is just for me.

MOTHER: Goldilocks it is your birthday cake but you must share it with your friends and us.

GOLDILOCKS: No, I don't want to!

FATHER: Oh! Goldilocks, that's very rude.

GOLDILOCKS: I don't care.

(Goldilocks starts eating.)

MOTHER: Can I have a slice?

GOLDILOCKS: I said No!

(Mother cries.)

FATHER: Goldilocks, sharing is caring. Do you agree, friends? Sharing is caring.

GOLDILOCKS: I don't care.

FATHER: Goldilocks, be polite please.

GOLDILOCKS: Ok. But I want to play hide and seek with you again!

MOTHER: Hide and seek again Goldilocks?

GOLDILOCKS: Please, Oh, pretty please!

MOTHER: OK! But first we need to take the rubbish out to the garden.

GOLDILOCKS: What a pain!

FATHER: Please, Goldilocks, help us and then we will play hide and seek again.

GOLDILOCKS: OK, I trust you.

MOTHER: So, here are the bins. What is the blue one for?





GOLDILOCKS: Paper and cardboard.

FATHER: Very good. What about the green one?

GOLDILOCKS: This one is for glass.

MOTHER: What's the yellow one for?

GOLDILOCKS: Plastic.

FATHER: And the black one?

GOLDILOCKS: Compost or food waste.

MOTHER: She's so smart.

FATHER: So, Goldilocks. Your friends must also know what the bins are for.

(He asks the audience.)

Can you tell me what goes in each bin? Green? Black? Yellow? Blue? Wow they are also very smart. Thanks guys. You must remember the three R's: Reduce, Reuse and Recycle.

GOLDILOCKS: Very interesting dad. Can we play hide and seek now?

FATHER: Again?

GOLDILOCKS: You promised me.

MOTHER: Ok, but this is the last time Goldilocks. I'm so tired.

GOLDILOCKS: Sure, it will be the last time.

FATHER: Please don't hide far away.

GOLDILOCKS: You can count now. Count to ten.

MOTHER: Ok, I'll do that.

(To the audience:)





Please help me if I get lost. 1,2,4... Ok, ok, I'll start again. Ten! We're coming Goldilocks.

FATHER: Where did she go? To my left? To my right?

(They try to look for Goldilocks but they cannot find her.)

FATHER: Goldilocks!! Goldilocks!!

MOTHER: Oh! I think she's lost. My darling daughter. We need to find her.

(Goldilocks enters and hides behind a stone.)

GOLDILOCKS: Well, I'm sure they won't find me here.

(Time passes)

They're taking a long time. Since they couldn't find me... I win! Oh! I'm so happy but I am a bit cold. I must go home now. Hey friends? Do you know the way home? Is it on my right? Is it on my left? Is it all straight? Ok! I'll follow this path. Oh Thank you for helping me guys! I'm so happy now. I'm so happy that I could sing. Hey! Do you know that song? If you're happy and you know it clap your hands? Should we sing it all together? Ok Let's do it!

(Song.)

SCENE 2. BEARS' HOUSE

(Music. The scene is set in the bears' house.)

DADDY BEAR: (To audience.)

Good morning! Hello. My name is Daddy Bear. I just woke up and I need to stretch a little bit.

Do you want to stretch with me? So let's stretch?

MUMMY BEAR: Good morning! Hello, kids! My name is Mildred and I am Mummy Bear. What is all that

noise?

DADDY BEAR: These are my friends and they are stretching with me.





MUMMY BEAR: Oh! They are so cute. I want to stretch with them as well.

(She tries to stretch but falls down.)

TEDDY: Good morning Daddy, Good morning Mummy!

DADDY BEAR: Hi Teddy, say hello to our friends!

TEDDY: I can't.

MUMMY BEAR: That's not very polite

DADDY BEAR: Why?

TEDDY: Because... I need to wee.

(Teddy exits for a moment.)

TEDDY: Sorry friends! My name is Teddy!

(Daddy Bear gives out some toothbrushes.)

DADDY BEAR: First, we must wash our face and our hands, and then we will brush our teeth.

MUMMY BEAR: OK, now we must do some exercise routines.

(To the audience.)

Come on guys! To be fit and healthy you must exercise! Touch your head, now shoulders, then your knees and toes. Good! Where are your eyes? Yes! And your ears? Good! And where is your mouth? Yes! And where is your nose?





(Song)

HEAD, SHOULDERS, KNEES AND TOES

And eyes, and ears, and mouth, and nose. Head,

shoulders, knees and toes, knees and toes.

TEDDY: Wow! Now I feel fit, but I need my breakfast.

DADDY BEAR: Are you hungry?

MUMMY BEAR AND TEDDY: Yes! We are very hungry!

DADDY BEAR: Well then, let's make breakfast. Please help me.

MUMMY BEAR: Tablecloth....

TEDDY: Napkins....

MUMMY BEAR: Cups...

TEDDY: Spoons...

DADDY BEAR: Hot milk...

TEDDY: Honey....

MUMMY BEAR: Cereal. Honey pops! Yum, yum, yum! (They sit down to eat.)

DADDY BEAR: I'm starving. (He tries a spoonful and shouts out. He has burnt his tongue.) Ahhhhhh!

TEDDY: What?

DADDY BEAR: It's so hot! It burns!

MUMMY BEAR: I'm going to the river to have a bath while breakfast cools down.

TEDDY: Oh I love the river. Can I come with you mum?

DADDY BEAR: Why don't we all go!!! The river is so much fun!

TEDDY: (Singing.) Let's go let's go, let's go...

DADDY BEAR: To the river!





(Enter Goldilocks.)

GOLDILOCKS: I am lost! I am very tired.

(To the audience.)

What can I do? Oh, what a beautiful house!

(Goldilocks enters the house.)

GOLDILOCKS: Is anyone here? Hello? Anybody? Oh this place is a mess. The people who lives here don't

know how to recycle. The rubbish is all mixed up!

(Goldilocks sees the table laid out for breakfast.)

GOLDILOCKS: Oatmeal! Oh gosh! I'm starving! Yummy I love it!

(Goldilocks starts to eat from Daddy Bear's bowl.)

Ah! It's too hot!

(She tries Mummy Bear's bowl.)

Ah! It's too cold!

(She tries Teddy's bowl.)

Yum! This one is just right!

(Goldilocks eats.)

Oh I'm so tired now! Look at these chairs! Oh, no! This one is too hard.

(She sits in Mummy Bear's chair.)

This one is too soft! What's the matter with these people?





	(She sits in Teddy's chair.)
	This one is just right!
	(The chair breaks. She falls down.)
	Silly chair!
	(Goldilocks sees the beds.)
	Oh! Look at those beds!
	(First she tries Daddy Bear's bed.)
	It's too hard!
	(Gets up and tries Mummy Bear's bed.)
	This one is too soft!
	(Tries Teddy's bed.)
	This one is just right! Not too hard, not too soft! Just perfect.
	(She falls asleep. The bears enter the house.)
MUMMY BEAR:	Oh! The river was perfect. It was so much fun.
TEDDY:	Daddy, I'm so hungry
DADDY BEAR:	Yes! Breakfast is waiting for us!
(Goldilocks snores.)	





MUMMY BEAR: What is that noise?

(They listen, Goldilocks snores again. The bears are scared. Goldilocks snores again.)

DADDY BEAR: There must be pigs sniffing around our house.

MUMMY BEAR: Oh! Someone has tried my porridge!

TEDDY: (Sees his empty bowl.) Daddy! Someone has eaten my porridge!

DADDY BEAR: So they have, son!

TEDDY: (*Crying.*) I am so hungry. I need something to eat.

DADDY BEAR: (Looking at his chair.) And someone has been sitting in my chair!

MUMMY BEAR: Oh! My chair has also been used.

TEDDY: Daddy, someone has been sitting in my chair too... and it's broken! Why? Why?

(Teddy starts crying and Daddy Bear tries to calm him down.)

I'm so unlucky.

(Goldilocks snores again.)

MUMMY BEAR: Oh dear! Someone's in our room.

TEDDY: A thief! He broke my chair and ate my porridge!





(He cries.)

DADDY BEAR: Someone's been sleeping in my bed!

MUMMY BEAR: My bed has also been unmade.

TEDDY: Oh! Daddy! Someone has been sleeping on my bed too... and she's still there!

(Goldilocks wakes up and sees the bears.)

GOLDILOCKS: (Frightened.) Oh, no! Bears! Help!

MUMMY BEAR: She's a little girl! What are you doing here?

TEDDY: Oh! Daddy, I want to be her friend. She's my age. How old are you?

GOLDILOCKS: I'm nine.

TEDDY: Yes, she's my age.

DADDY BEAR: (To Goldilocks.) What are you doing in my house?

GOLDILOCKS: Please! I'm sorry! I got lost and I was so tired.

DADDY BEAR: What's your name, girl?

GOLDILOCKS: My name is Goldilocks.

DADDY BEAR: Goldilocks, why did you make all this mess?

GOLDILOCKS: Well....

DADDY BEAR: Well?

TEDDY: My name is Teddy. Oh! What a beautiful bear, can I see it?

GOLDILOCKS: No. He's mine. He's so funny. He looks like you





TEDDY: I have a doll that looks like you. (*He takes out a blonde doll.*) We can play together.

MUMMY BEAR: Yes. Sharing is caring, kids

DADDY BEAR: Goldilocks, why did you break the chair?

TEDDY: Yes, why? It's my chair!

GOLDILOCKS: It was an accident.

TEDDY: Don't worry! Maybe dad can fix my chair.

DADDY BEAR: Yes, I'll fix it! Don't worry Goldilocks.

MUMMY BEAR: You can play together while your dad is fixing the chair.

TEDDY: Yes! Yes! Oh Mummy. I'm so happy I have a new friend.

DADDY BEAR: Great!

GOLDILOCKS: Let's play! Let's jump on the beds!

TEDDY: Yes. That would be so much fun!

MUMMY BEAR: But...

TEDDY: Can we jump on the beds mummy?

MUMMY BEAR: Ok. But not for too long. The beds aren't strong enough.

TEDDY: Can we swap our dolls?

DADDY BEAR: But, my bear is mine...

DADDY BEAR: Goldilocks, sharing is...

(He asks to the audience. Waits for reply.)

GOLDILOCKS: Ok, you can play with my bear. I'll name him after you. Teddy

TEDDY: (Sharing his doll with Goldilocks.) Her name is Goldilocks too.





GOLDILOCKS: Let's jump on the beds

(Song.)

DADDY BEAR: Guys, can you please stop singing and jumping.

TEDDY: Why dad?

DADDY BEAR: I have a headache.

DADDY BEAR: And we still need to tidy the house.

GOLDILOCKS: Hey, I can help you

TEDDY: Yes please. Working together is called: teamwork!

GOLDILOCKS: Do you know how to recycle?

TEDDY: Re... what?





GOLDILOCKS: I'll show you.

TEDDY: Can you teach me please?

DADDY BEAR: Okay. This is very exciting. Working together as a family.

TEDDY: What do we do?

GOLDILOCKS: (To the audience.) Can you teach them how to recycle?

MUMMY BEAR: Yes! Teamwork!

GOLDILOCKS: (Carrying rubbish bags.)

Here are some rubbish bags for recycling. What do we put in the yellow bags friends? Yes, we put things made out of plastic. What do we put in the blue bag? Yes! Oh they are so smart. Yes, we put paper in the blue one. And what about the green bag? Good, we put glass in the green one. And in the organic bag we put food. Let's practise.

(To the bears:)

Where you should put this plastic bottle?

TEDDY: Plastic... in the yellow bag.

GOLDILOCKS: (*To mummy bear.*) Excellent! And what about a glass bottle?

MUMMY BEAR: Glass... in the green one.

GOLDILOCKS: Good! And this piece of paper?

DADDY BEAR: Paper... in the blue bag.

GOLDILOCKS: Yes! I hope you learned the lesson!

TEDDY: Yes Goldilocks! Look, I have this banana. (*Teddy eats the banana.*) Now I have to put the

skin in the blue bag.

GOLDILOCKS: What?

TEDDY: Just kidding! It goes in the organic bag.

GOLDILOCKS: Very good, Teddy!





TEDDY: Daddy, can we go and play in the woods?

DADDY BEAR: Ok! But first, help us finish tidying up.

TEDDY: Yes, teamwork! Goldilocks, help us, please.

GOLDILOCKS: Of course. Teamwork!

(They tidy the house up with some music.)

TEDDY: That's it! Can we go out and play now? Please? Please? Please?

DADDY BEAR: Okay, but stay close to the house.

TEDDY: Goodbye, Daddy!

GOLDILOCKS: Goodbye, Sir, Madam! Thank you very much for your hospitality. You are amazing.

MUMMY BEAR: Goodbye! And remember, stay close to the house!

TEDDY: Okay. Dad, thank you.

GOLDILOCKS: Thank you, sir. We'll try to find you honey.

DADDY BEAR: Thank you, Goldilocks!

(Teddy and Goldilocks go to the forest and start playing with their toys, they share them. They exit, playing and singing. The Goldilocks' teddy bear falls down.)

SCENE 3. THE FOREST

(Enter Father and Mother, looking for Goldilocks.)





FATHER: Goldilocks!

(To the audience.)

Have you seen Goldilocks?

MOTHER: Oh my little daughter. Please, come back. Goldilocks!!

(She sees the Teddy bear on the floor.)

Oh! Look honey! Goldilocks's bear!

FATHER: (He asks the audience.) Do you know who left this teddy bear here? Did you see

Goldilocks?

(Exit parents. Enter Goldilocks and Teddy, playing with their toys.)

GOLDILOCKS: Let's play hide and seek!

TEDDY: Okay! I'll hide

GOLDILOCKS: I think I have to go back home. Mum and dad will be worried.

TEDDY: I can go with you. Do you know the way back?

GOLDILOCKS: No. I am lost. I have lost my parents.

(She cries and Teddy hugs her while the parents enter.)

MOTHER: Oh look, father. A bear is attacking Goldilocks! Let's get him!

(The father traps Teddy.)





FATHER: Got you! Goldilocks, move away, hurry! This bear is very dangerous!

GOLDILOCKS: Teddy! No, Dad, he's my friend!

TEDDY: Please, I didn't do anything!

MOTHER: Ha! Leave our daughter alone! Goldilocks, are you okay?

GOLDILOCKS: Yes, mum. But, please! Teddy is my friend. I was lost in the forest and he saved me. His

family, including him, and I learned some very important lessons today. Let him go!

FATHER: What lessons did you learn?

GOLDILOCKS: The importance of friendship, sharing and working as a team.

MOTHER: Goldilocks! Have you learned how to share with others and work as a team?

GOLDILOCKS: Yes, mum! Sharing is caring! Please let him go!

FATHER: I can't. Bears are dangerous.

GOLDILOCKS: You're wrong! Teddy is the best friend I could have ever asked for.

(They hug each other.)

FATHER: Ok, if you are my daughter's friend then you are a friend of mine as well.

MOTHER: Yes, I agree. Come for lunch with us.

TEDDY: Thank you, but I can't. I must go home now. My Mummy and Daddy will be worried!

FATHER: Okay. Teddy! Thanks for keeping Goldilocks safe and sound.

TEDDY: Okay, Sir! Goodbye! Thank you, Goldilocks!

(Teddy and Goldilocks hug.)

You're a good friend. Goodbye! Come and visit me sometime!

GOLDILOCKS: I will! Goodbye!





(He leaves.)

GOLDILOCKS: (Goldilocks gives her teddy to her parents.) I'm sorry mum and dad. I promise to share

everything with you!

MOTHER: You have finally learned to share. I am very proud of you!

GOLDILOCKS: Yes mum! You can have much more fun when you share with your friends.

PARENTS: Very good, Goldilocks. We're very proud of you.

(They leave.)
